To explore the introduction of establishing a girls/ladies football section at varying age groups, through partnerships with Hungerford Primary School and John O'Gaunt School.
To actively promote the Club to increase the profile throughout the local community.

- To fill in existing team gaps with the aim of providing football at all levels. This includes the recruitment of new managers, coaches and players.
- To ensure that volunteers, managers, coaches and club officials receive adequate training to undertake their roles.

- To encourage and support club members in their attempts to gain coaching, refereeing, first aid and other qualifications.
- To encourage all our Coaches and helpers to attend an FA recognised 'Working with Young Children' seminar.

SUBSCRIPTION FEES FOR 2018-2019 SEASON

Our fees for the 2018-2019 season are as follows:-

Under 6 Age Group

£65.00

Under 7 to Under 16 Age Groups

1st child - £115.00

2nd child - £105.00 in any one family

3rd child - £95.00 in any one family

Subscription fees may be paid in 3 instalments by post-dated cheques – the first payment of £40 must be made when the player submits their Registration Form, the second and third payments of £40 and £35, respectively must be paid at monthly intervals thereafter, ensuring full fees are paid within 3 months of Registration.

Please note that any charges incurred by the Club for cheques returned by the bank, will be passed onto the person who raised the cheque.

Respect Code of Conduct

Young Players

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game.

As a player, you have a big part to play. That's why The FA is asking every player to follow a Respect Code of Conduct.

When playing football, I will:

- Always play to the best of my ability
- Play fairly – I won't cheat, complain or waste time
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee or my coach/manager
 - Play by the rules, as directed by the referee
 - Shake hands with the other team and referee at the end of the game
 - Listen and respond to what my coach/ team manager tells me
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I'm unhappy about anything at my club.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or The FA:

I may:

- Be required to apologise to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Receive a formal warning from the coach or the club committee
- Be dropped or substituted
- Be suspended from training
- Be required to leave the club.

In addition:

- My club, County FA or The FA may make my parent or carer aware of any infringements of the Code of Conduct
- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club.

Respect Code of Conduct

Spectators and Parents/Carers

We all have a responsibility to promote high standards of behaviour in the game. This club is supporting The FA's Respect programme to ensure football can be enjoyed in a safe, positive environment. Remember children's football is a time for them to develop their technical, physical, tactical and social skills. Winning isn't everything.

Play your part and observe The FA's Respect Code of Conduct for spectators and parents/carers at all times.

I will:

- Remember that children play for FUN
- Applaud effort and good play as well as success
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Remain outside the field of play and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
- Let the coach do their job and not confuse the players by telling them what to do
- Encourage the players to respect the opposition, referee and match officials
- Avoid criticising a player for making a mistake – mistakes are part of learning
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting, or abusive language or behaviour.

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA, league or The FA:

I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning from a club or league official
- Required to meet with the club, league or County FA Welfare Officer
- Required to meet with the club committee
- Obligated to undertake an FA education course
- Obligated to leave the match venue by the club
- Requested by the club not to attend future games
- Suspended or have my club membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents.

In addition:

- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and/ or suspension on the club.
