To explore the introduction of establishing a girls/ladies football section at varying age groups, through partnerships with Hungerford Primary School and John O'Gaunt School.
To actively promote the Club to increase the profile throughout the local community.

- Pitch fees, John O'Gaunt School Astro Turf fees & Hungerford Leisure Centre fees for U6 indoor winter training
- Referee costs (where applicable)
- Player kit consisting of shirt/shorts/socks (U6 age group receive a Club T-shirt)
- Training equipment eg balls, nets, rebounders, cones, poles, bibs, Respect Barriers etc
- Purchase of First Aid kits
- Pitch marking paint
- Costs associated with maintenance of mower
- Christmas Event – present for each registered player
